Masterpiece of the Month

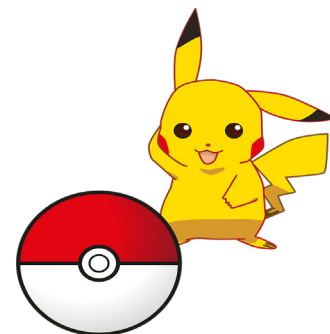
Wednesday, August 23, 4:00 PM

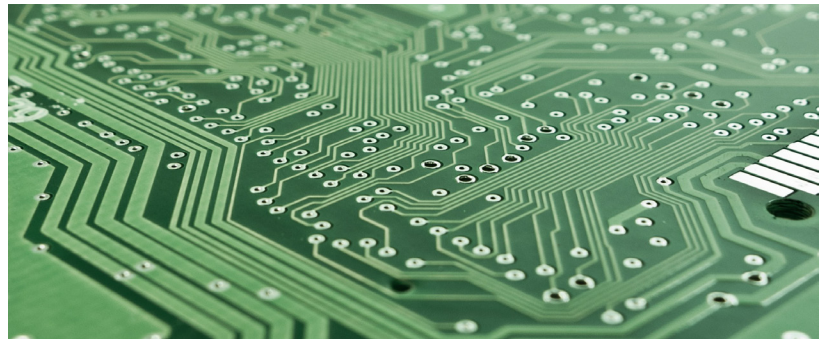

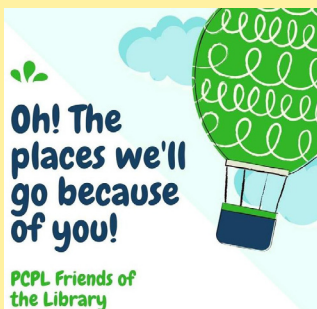
Time Travelin' Genealogy Guild
