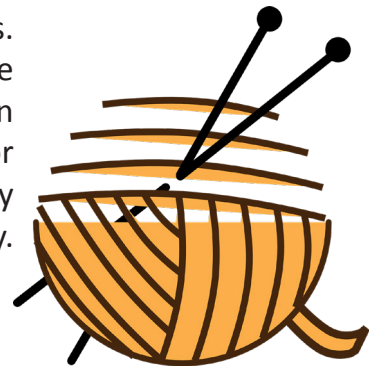

Wednesday, March 13, 6:30 PM

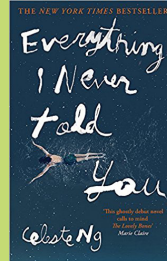

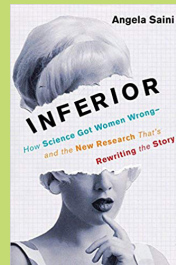
