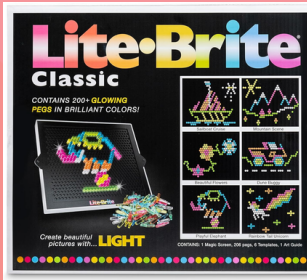

Browse a variety of fiction & non-fiction books for adults, teens, and kids. Look for as long as you would like and then pay at the Circulation Desk.

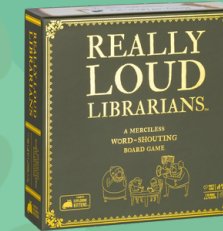
Book Sale is located on the Lower Level beside the stairs and Meeting Rooms. The Friends of the Library are responsible for the book sale.

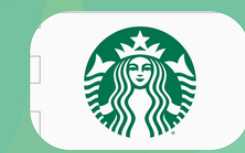

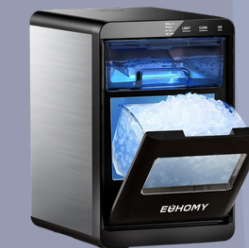

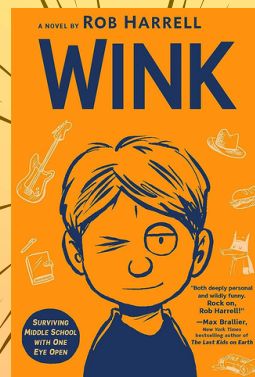


Author Visit: Rob Harrell
