Ben is a U.S. Air Force Veteran, musician, and Indie author who lives in Linton, IN, with his wife and two kids.

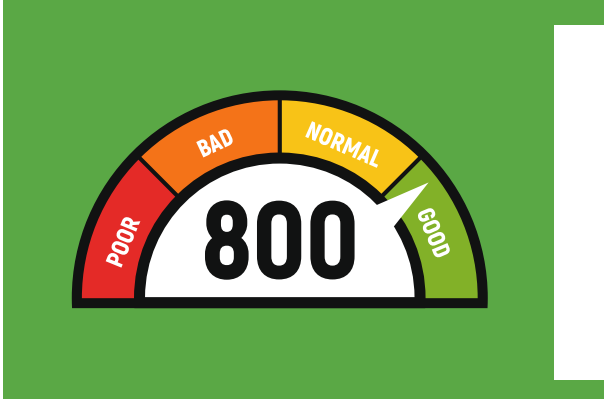
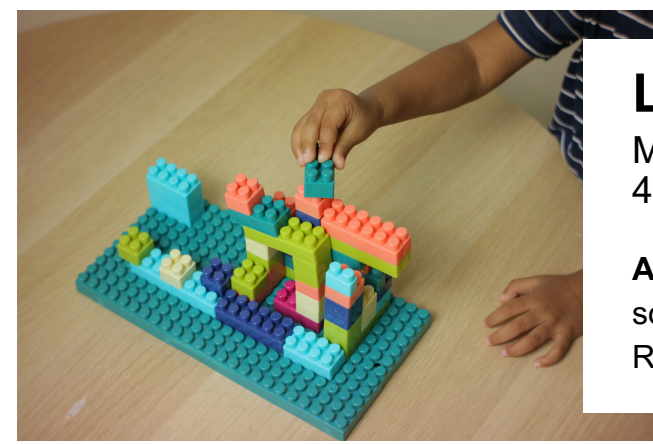
