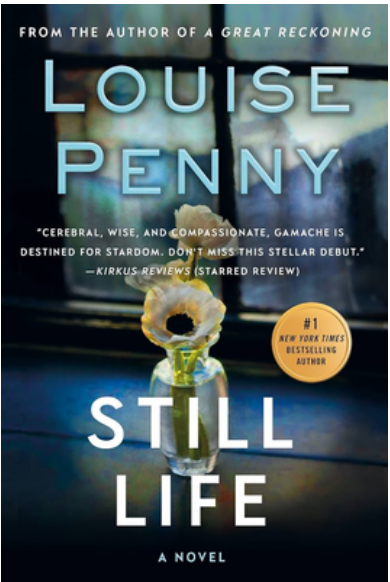
Adult Book Club

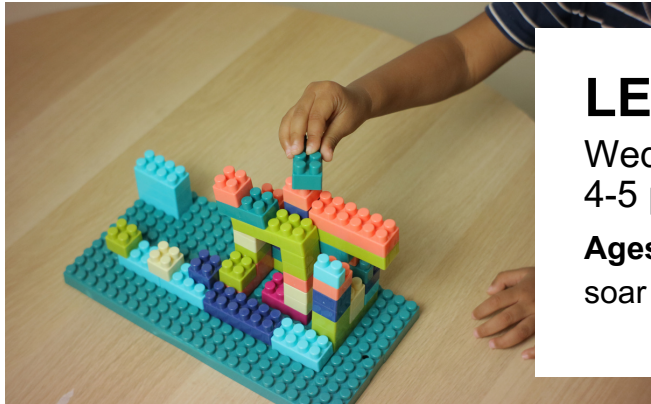
New Adult Book Club

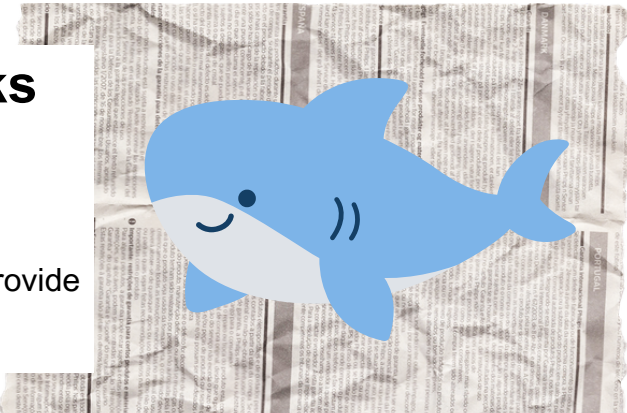
